Zouch Audio are high end audio dealers, so they know good cables when they hear them.

But as high end dealers, they have access to many other high end speaker cables – including the Black Rhodium Storm.

So what makes Thunder so special. It was designed simply to be a lower impedance version of Black Rhodium Athena and Storm.

But to build a cable so thick, Black Rhodium had to build it slightly differently.

It is those differences from Athena and Storm that make Thunder deliver such beautiful sound.

So at Black Rhodium, we designed a test cable around those design features where Thunder differed.

We left out the most expensive parts of Thunder, but we included some essential features of our high end cables.

We like the result. Our test cable sounded better to our ears than everything else except Thunder.

We were on the right track.

So we used these same exclusive design features from Thunder on a new cable of very modest pretensions.

We called it Foxtrot and we really wanted to dance.

We liked it so much that we build it with our very best loudspeaker connectors.

These are the Graham Nalty GN-1 Straight Line Contact' connectors for which we have not heard any equal.

We called it QUICKSTEP and we wanted to dance much faster to the music.

But even though these cables sounded so good, they had no Graham Nalty Vibration Stabilisers.

So we build two more cables, with heavier gauge wire and reduced their vibration with VS-4 at the end of each wire.

We still had not used any of our wonderful cryogenically treated cables.

So we created Breeze and Tempest.

They all sound wonderful, but they needed to be matched by interconnect cables of the same quality.

So we created, Harmony, Concerto and Maestro.

Harmony gives us no better way to enjoy the best of Foxtrot and Quickstep loudspeaker cables.

Concerto gives us no better way to enjoy the best of Rumba and Samba loudspeaker cables.

Maestro gives us no better way to enjoy the best of Breeze and Tempest loudspeaker cables.

We hope you enjoy music.

We do – with these cables of course.
